Policy governing the Advising Members as defined in the By Laws.

An “Advising member” is a volunteer who has signed our code of conduct.

An “Advising member” is allowed to attend a board meeting when invited by any committee chair.

An “Advising member” is a non-voting member and plays no role in the election of directors. (See bylaw definition of “Advising Member”)

Nominations for an “Advising Member” can be made by any director at any time.

An “Advising member” is appointed and approved by board resolution for up to a one year term or the next AGM whichever comes first. Advising Members Terms can be renewed indefinitely by board resolution.

An “Advising Member” can submit the written resignation at any time, to be effective immediately or at a stated future date.

An “Advising Member” can have their membership revoked at any time by a board resolution. Revoked membership are effective immediately or at a future date specified in the motion to revoke membership.

By signing our code of conduct an “advising member” becomes bound to our confidentiality rules and our conflict of interest rules. Advising members must be fully briefed on the importance of both before they sign and apply for membership.
